### Academic Services

- **Academic Affairs (x7604)** is responsible for the quality and integrity of all academic programs; the library, student academic support services including advising, disability services and testing, assessment, institutional research, the Registrar's office and all matters associated with faculty.
- **Center for Academic Support & Excellence (x8097)** provides various academic services to all Marian students. Those services include academic advising, academic support, academic testing, tutor programs, CLEP testing, Disability Services and accommodations, EXCEL and Undeclared Programs, practice PRAXIS I exams and resources, PRAXIS II resources, NCLEX resources and much more.
- **Disability Services (x8951)** provides guidance and advocacy for students who are living with a disability. Services include: exam/test accommodations, note-taking assistance, residence hall accommodations, and alternative media methods.
- **Learning and Writing Center (Math x8151, Reading x8586, Science x8751, Writing x8764 and ELL x8764)** provides academic support for students who need assistance, review or consultation in math, reading, science and writing. Support is available to students who need assistance with study skills, standardized testing by taking advantage of personal tutoring and software for improving basic skills.
- **Career & Graduate School Services (x7161)** can discuss career options that match interests and skills, discuss life goals and how to meet them and provide valuable resources for major selection and job search process.
