OFFICIAL ADMISSION TO THE UPPER DIVISION NURSING MAJOR

Students submit an application for admission to the Upper Division Nursing major when enrolled in NUR 202. Admission decisions are made at end of Sophomore year. Minimum requirements:

- Cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or higher.
- All but 12 credits of Liberal Arts core requirements met prior to admission to Junior level; **ENG 105, ENG 106, PSY 105, BIO 201, BIO 202, BIO 210, BIO 100 & CHE 103 and MAT elective completed with GPA of 2.00 or better.**
- Only one required math or one required science course with a grade less than 2.0 will be allowed to be repeated once to obtain a grade of 2.0 or better for that course. This requirement applies to all courses taken at Marian University as well as those transferred in for credit.
- At least 9 earned Marian University credits including, NUR 201 and NUR 202 with GPA of 2.0 or better.
- NUR 230 with a GPA of 2.00 or better.
- Health Records, CPR Certification, Blood Borne Pathogen Overview completed.
- ***Minimum of 90% on Math for Meds Competency Exam.
