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CRITERIA FOR OFFICIAL PROGRESSION TO THE NURSING MAJOR

Minimum requirements for official progression:

- 1) Current licensure as a registered nurse. RN license must be encumbered and unrestricted, and have no limitations specified.
- 2) All but 15 credits of Liberal Arts core requirements met. (The requirement for a lab science is waived for students in this program)
- 3) Prior credit earned must include ENG 105 and ENG 106 or ENG 230, and the MAT common core course (or its equivalent) with a grade of C (2.0) or higher.

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NUR 300-400: Minimum of a C (2.0) is required in every course. Only one 300-400-level nursing course with a grade less than C (2.0) will be allowed to be repeated once to obtain a grade of C (2.0) or better for that course. For students bridging into the MSN program, you must earn a B or better in the graduate courses.

BSN degree graduates who have completed their degree by taking three graduate courses may apply these credits (maximum 9) to the MSN program. All MSN courses must be completed within 3 years of starting the MSN program.
