

## List of Building Safe Shelter Areas

<p>Please use this list during severe weather and tornado warnings. Note: When taking shelter remember to stay as far away from windows as possible, the lowest level of a building without windows is considered to be a safe area, (this includes building stairwells without windows, and restrooms).</p>	
If you are in this Building...	Shelter in these areas...
<b>74 S. NATIONAL AVENUE</b>	Seek shelter in Basement of Duplex 60 or internal lower level office/storage
<b>102 S. NATIONAL AVENUE</b>	Basement
<b>761 E. DIVISION</b>	Basement
<b>ADMINISTRATION BUILDING (45 S. National Avenue)</b>	1st floor through the College of Arts, Sciences & Letters Office complex (faculty row). The inner-offices in faculty row will be used as over-flow. The following offices will be used as overflow as well: A106, A108, A110, A111, restrooms
<b>AGNES CENTER</b>	Basement
<b>APPLETON CENTER</b>	Interior lounge or Rooms 102 and 104, or restrooms
<b>BEN SADOFF SCIENCE BUILDING</b>	1st floor center hallway or restrooms
<b>BREEZEWAY (Not safe for shelter)</b>	Seek shelter in the Administrative Building 1st floor through the College of Arts, Sciences & Letters Office complex (faculty row). The inner-offices in faculty row will be used as over-flow. The following offices will be used as overflow as well: A106, A108, A110, A111, restrooms 1st floor hallway
<b>CAMPUS MAINTENANCE and GROUNDS GARAGE (Not safe for shelter)</b>	Seek shelter in the HORNUNG STUDENT CENTER -Inner hallways (excluding the main hallway), restrooms, Palen Room, Student Life Office suite
<b>CARDINAL MEYER LIBRARY</b>	Seek shelter in the Administrative Building 1st floor through the College of Arts, Sciences & Letters Office complex (faculty row). The inner-offices in faculty row will be used as over-flow. The following offices will be used as overflow as well: A106, A108, A110, A111, restrooms 1st floor hallway, or Library 1st floor interior offices, or restrooms
<b>CASE OFFICE/CAMPUS MINISTRY/TESTING (Mobile Unites East and West)</b>	Seek shelter in HORNUNG STUDENT CENTER – Inner hallways (excluding the main hallway, restrooms, Palen Room, Student Life Office suite
<b>CEDAR CREEK APARTMENTS</b>	Lowest level and restrooms
<b>CENTER FOR HEALTH PROFESSIONS</b>	Lower level
<b>COURTYARDS</b>	Lower level hallways, or restrooms
<b>DORCAS CHAPEL</b>	Seek shelter in the Administrative Building 1st floor through the College of Arts, Sciences & Letters Office complex (faculty row). The inner-offices in faculty row will be used as over-flow. The following offices will be used as overflow as well: A106, A108, A110, A111, restrooms, or restrooms in front of Chapel
<b>DUPLEXES</b>	Basements
<b>GYMNASIUM</b>	Interior locker rooms or restrooms

<b>HEALTH &amp; WELLNESS CENTER</b>	Lower level Regina Hall
<b>HERR-BAKER BASEBALL FIELD</b>	Restrooms
<b>HORNUNG STUDENT CENTER</b>	Inner hallways (excluding the main hallway), restrooms, Palen Room, Student Life Office suite
<b>HOWARD SADOFF GYMNASIUM</b>	Lower level locker rooms or restrooms
<b>KUBER CENTER</b>	Stay indoors, and away from windows.
<b>LENZ FIELD HOUSE</b>	Restrooms
<b>NABER HALL</b>	1st floor restrooms, 1st floor lounge, and the hallway directly behind the Naber front door area
<b>REGINA HALL</b>	Basement hallways or restrooms
<b>SMITH FIELD CLUBHOUSE</b>	Restrooms or storage room  IMPORTANT NOTE ... PLEASE BE SURE THAT ALL GAS GRILLS ARE TURNED OFF.
<b>STAYER CENTER</b>	1st floor classrooms 116, 118, 122 and 124, and restrooms.  <b>IMPORTANT NOTICE for third floor occupants: the east and west stairwells exit outside on the first floor; therefore, if evacuees want to reach the first floor “safe areas” they must exit and re-enter the building. (Keep in mind that both stairwells are considered as “safe areas” as well as those listed above).</b>
<b>TODD WEIR CENTER/COMMON GROUNDS</b>	Seek shelter in the Regina Hall basement or restrooms
<b>TOWNHOUSES</b>	Basement
<b>UPWARD BOUND</b>	Basement
<b>WEST ALLIS CENTER</b>	Lowest level (hallway right next to the entrance of the church). Restrooms
